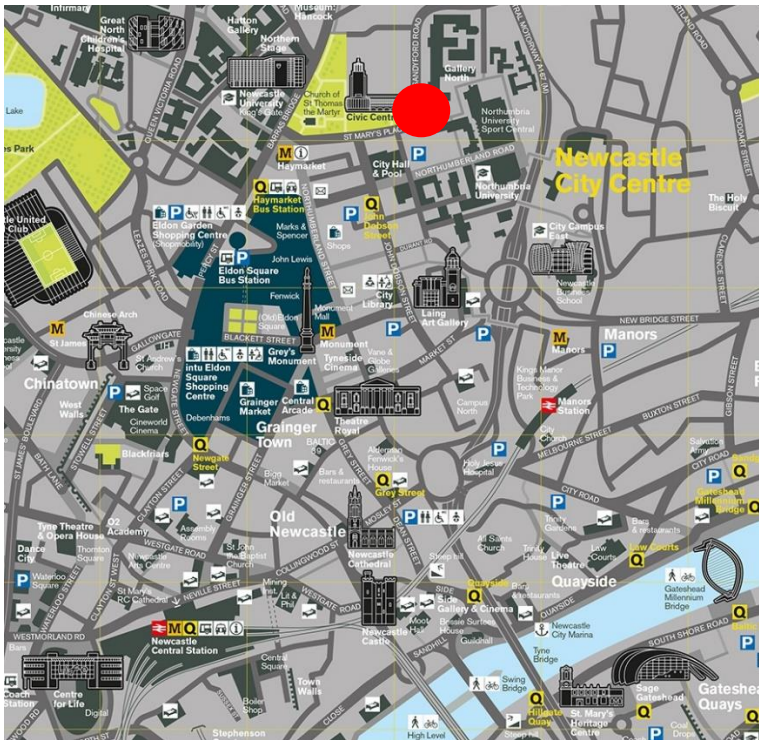
DETAILED INFORMATION FOR THE IIC

The IIC will be held at Sport Central, which is located in the city centre campus of Northumbria University.

Sport Central is a £30 million state of the art sports facility located in the heart of Newcastle city centre. The IIC will be held in the main arena which can be presented as 3 separate sports or one large hall. Sport Central is fully media enabled and is a regular venue for international elite level sporting events.





1. TRANSPORT

BY AIR

Newcastle International Airport has direct flights from many European countries including international hubs at Paris and Amsterdam. Newcastle International Airport is a 20-minute Metro ride from the city centre and the course venue.

BY TRAIN

Newcastle is two and a half hours away from London, Manchester, Glasgow and Edinburgh. Newcastle Central station is a 15-minute walk to the course venue and in walking distance of most of the city centre hotels.

BY SEA

DFDS seaways run a ferry from Amsterdam to the Port of Newcastle 7 times a week. The Ferry port is 10 miles from the venue and connected by Metro to the city centre.

BY ROAD

There are bus services from most major cities to Newcastle. There are over 10,000 car parking spaces in the city centre, but these all have daily charges.

2. ACCOMODATION

There are many hotels in the city centre within walking distance of the venue. There is also an underground metro station 500m from the venue which links the venue to more hotels around the city.

This will be a cashless course – no cash payments will be accepted and all financial transactions for the IIC will be online via bank transfer. As we are based in England, for ease of payment, all fees are payable in GBP (£ Sterling). We have kept the fee as close as possible to the IIC participation fees as set by the ITF at the time of issuing the joining details. For information, the Euro participation fee set by the ITF is: 1st-3rd Degrees - €120; 4th-6th Degrees - €150; 7th-8th Degrees - €75; 9th Degrees, €0.

Please Note: We have been made aware of recent changes in banking arrangements and are now being charged an additional fee to receive funds from overseas. Regretfully, we have to pass this charge on to participants. If you are transferring money from outside the UK, please ensure you add the International Payment Surcharge shown on the registration form.

Participants must also make application to their NA (National Association) or AA (Allied Association) to register their participation via the ITF online system.

8. SOCIAL EVENT

9. DEGREE TESTING

All candidates for a degree test during the IIC should note the following:

- Send your thesis, CV, application form, and letter of NA/AA approval through your National/Allied Association to the ITF HQ at least three months before the promotion date.
- Express your intention to grade also to the IIC organizers by sending an email to iicengland2022@gmail.com
- Pay the examiner grading fee in cash before the grading (please check with your NA/AA).
- Bring 5 wooden boards measured 30x30x2 cm (only up to 6th degree).
- No spectators are allowed during the degree promotion.

The candidate may be accompanied by his/her instructor.

10. NEWCASTLE AND THE SURROUNDING AREA

With its spectacular river gorge and the famous bridges that cross it, Newcastle upon Tyne is a former shipbuilding town that has rebuilt itself to become the number one short stay destination in the UK outside of London. The range of architecture, world class cultural attractions and its renowned nightlife make Newcastle a superb location for an International Instructor Course.
